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Rye YMCA Summer Childcare Program Q&A

Q: What are the dates of the summer childcare program?

A: The childcare program will run from June 29-August 14

Q: What are the hours of the program?

A: 9 am – 4 pm, Monday-Friday

Q: Where will the program be held?

A: At the Rye YMCA, 21 Locust Avenue, Rye.

Q: Will there be extended care for working parents?

A: Yes, there will be extended care hours from 8-9 am and 4-5:30 pm

Q: What ages will be served?

A: Under our current childcare license, we can serve children ages 5-12

Q: What is the cost of the program?

A: The program will cost \$365 per week, including extended care.

Q: Can I send my child(ren) for fewer than five days, at a pro-rated cost?

A: No. Due to staff/child(ren) ratios, the cost of care is for five days.

Q: I've already paid for camp. Can I apply my camp fee toward the childcare program?

A: Yes. If the camp fee was more than the childcare fee, we will send you a check for the difference by the end of June.

Q: If I've paid for camp and choose not to register my child for child care, when will I receive a camp refund?

A: We will mail camp refund checks by the end of June.

Q: Is financial aid available for the childcare program?

A: Yes. Thanks to the generosity of our donors, the Rye Y is able to offer financial assistance to those who need it. Please contact Barbara Hughes (barbara@ryeymca.org) for an application.

Q: Who will be running the childcare program?

A: The program will be run by Kathy Lynam, Senior Program Director for Family, Camp and Childcare; Liliana Gudino, Child Care Director; and the After School Adventures staff team.

Q: What activities will be offered?

A: Activities include arts & crafts, organized games, sports, STEAM, and more!

Q: What measures will be in place to prevent coronavirus transmission?

A: The Rye Y is working very hard to ensure a safe childcare experience. We will limit the

number of participants to a maximum of 60 children with no more than 10-12 children in each room. The groups will not interact with each other. Although the Rye Y may open in a very limited capacity in July, children in the childcare program will have little to no interaction with other Rye Y members.

We will implement stringent cleaning and sanitizing protocols. Children will be screened before entering the building every day and will be subject to temperature checks. We will follow strict procedures related to the child's health and the health of those in the household. All staff members will wear masks at all times and will be subject to daily temperature checks. For more details regarding screening, please contact Kathy Lynam at kathy@ryeymca.org
